This is a course for UCalgary undergraduate students who are preparing to apply to the Master of Architecture program.

Course Description

Develops advanced graphics and visualization techniques relevant to the architecture field, including but not limited to 3D modeling, rendering, parametric design, computational design, and digital fabrication.

Requirements

The successful candidate will have completed at least a master's degree in architecture or a related discipline and ideally have prior teaching experience at the post-secondary level.

5. Required qualification: professional proficiency in Revit, Rhino.Inside.Revit, Rhino, rendering software
6. Recommended qualifications: Grasshopper, Dynamo
7. Description of your qualifications in support of each course you are interested in teaching (could include evidence of teaching effectiveness.)

All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority. At the time of your application, please answer the following question: Are you a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada? (Yes/No)
